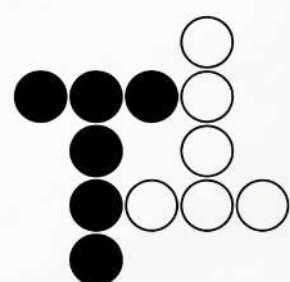

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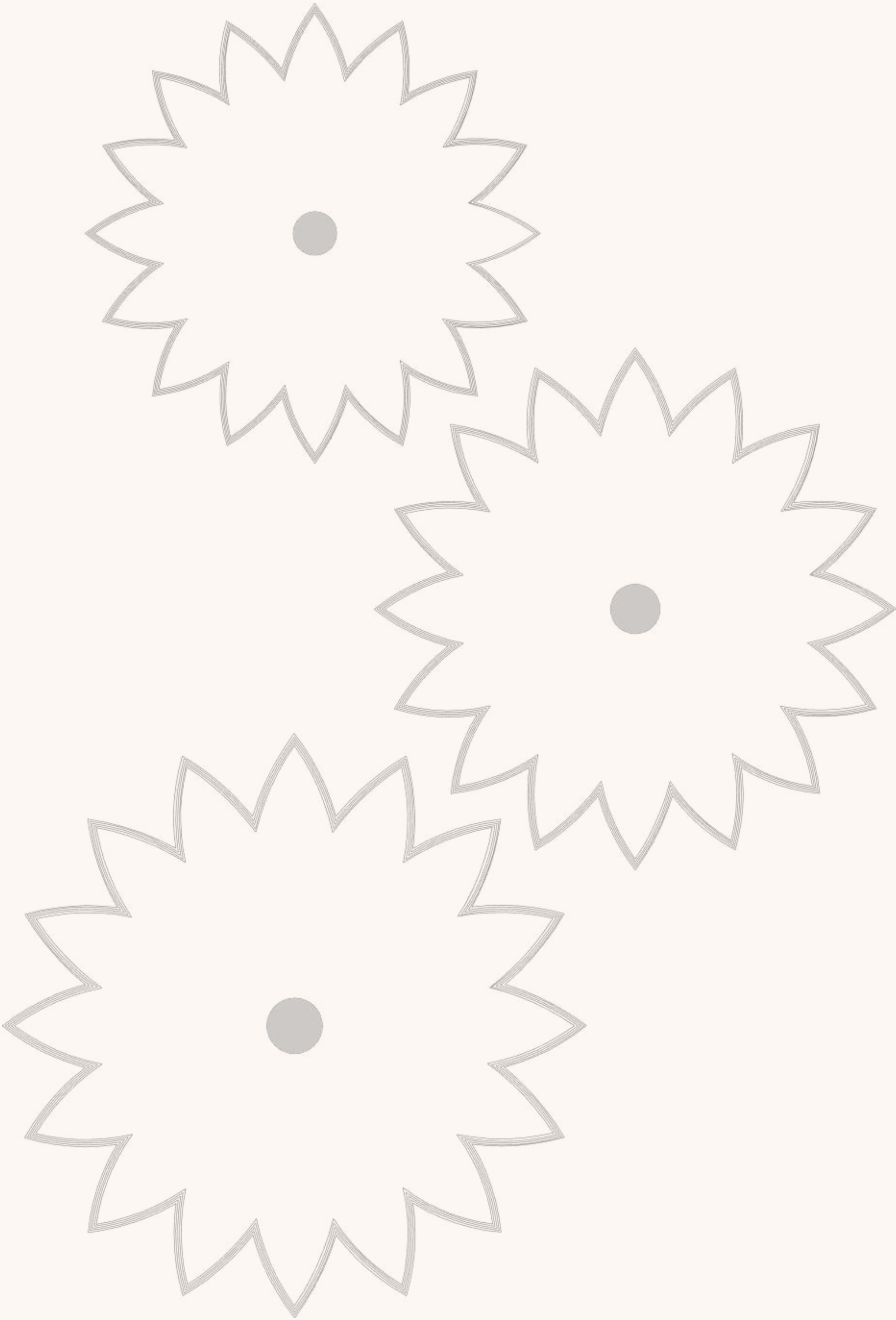

Corbel Table

The Corbel table is made from a charred timber stack transformed into a sculptural side table, made from interlocking wooden blocks whose stepped edges form a pixelated edge. Burnished in a deep matte black, the piece carries the grain and cracks of solid wood, giving weight, texture, and a grounded, elemental presence.

Two Moon Table

The combination of solid timber, woven texture, and simple geometry gives the table a strong material presence with practical everyday use.

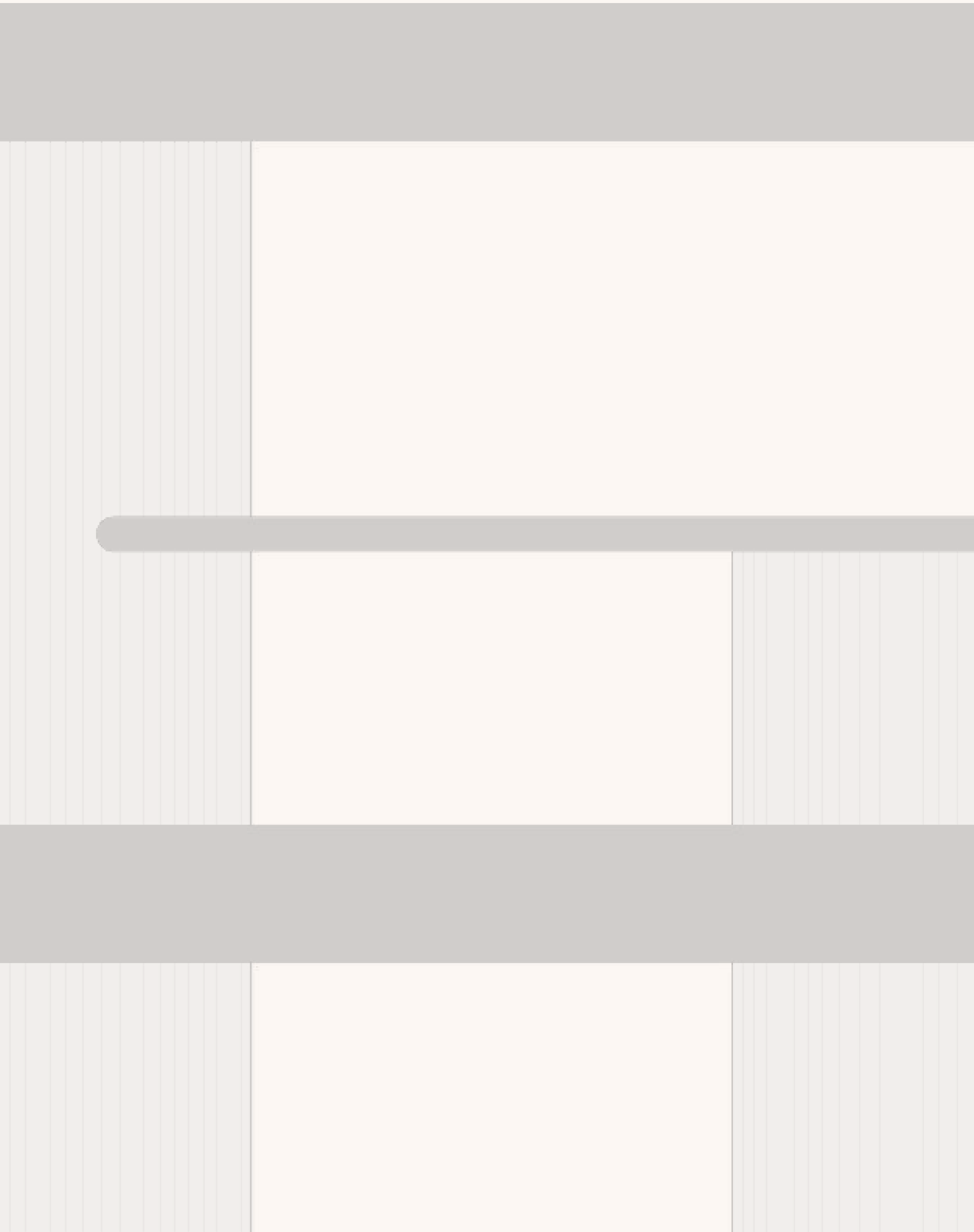

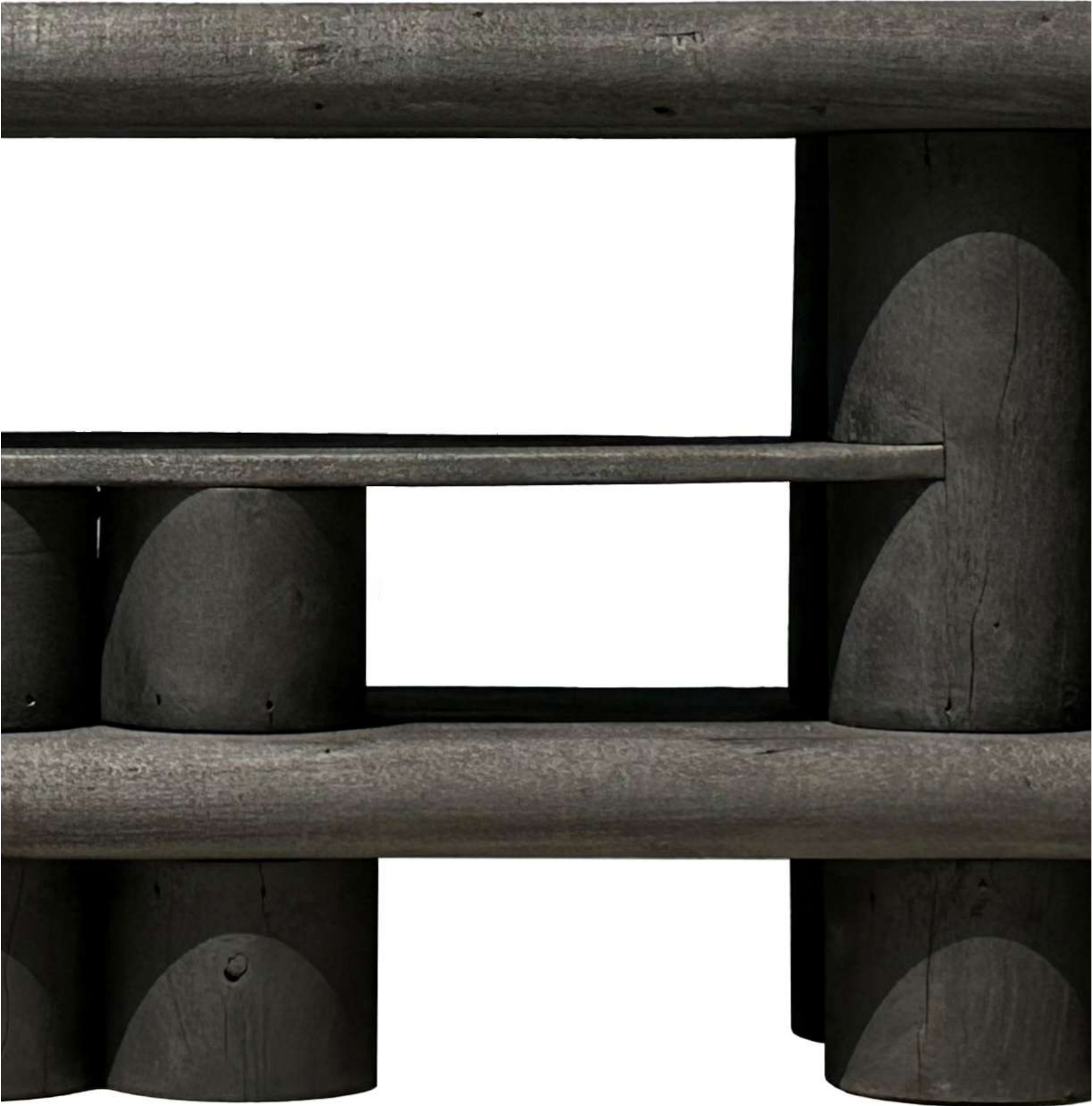

Bunji Table

This sculptural coffee table from Turning Tables by Attiq Ahmed is designed with a strong sense of proportion and materiality. Its elongated oval top and base are connected by three cylindrical supports, that give it both visual rhythm and structural balance. Rounded edges and smooth curves highlight the grain and warmth of the wood, making it a functional centrepiece that also reads as a statement piece in any room.

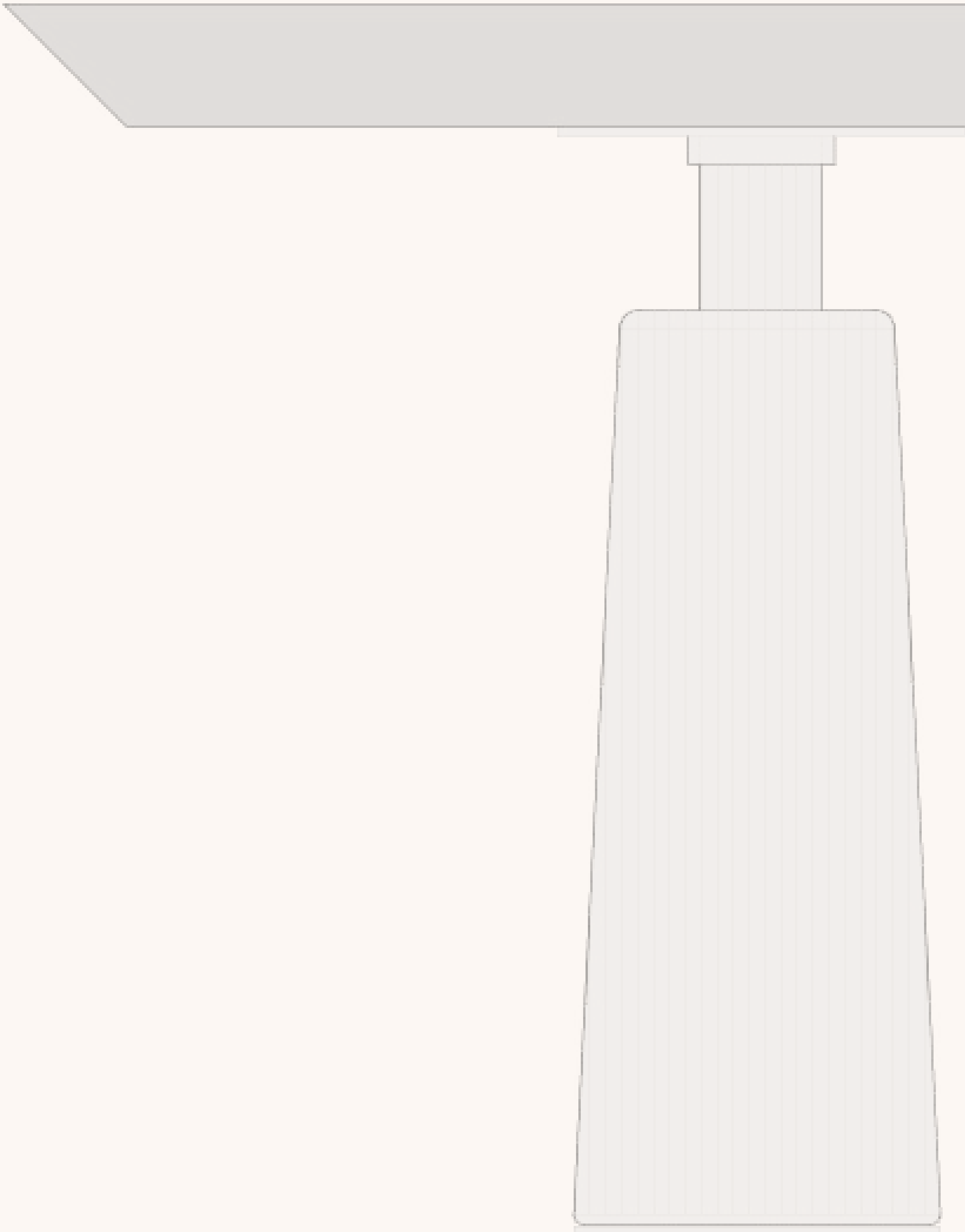

Urku Table

An oak frame holds a walnut mosaic, the varied grain and tone of natural variations in the wood giving depth and texture to the expansive surface. Six monolithic legs in solid travertine, support the table enriching it with a sense of permanence and weight. A concealed electroplated metal subframe provides additional structural strength, allowing the stone and timber to remain visually primary. Urku brings together craft, structure, and durability in a composed and enduring form.

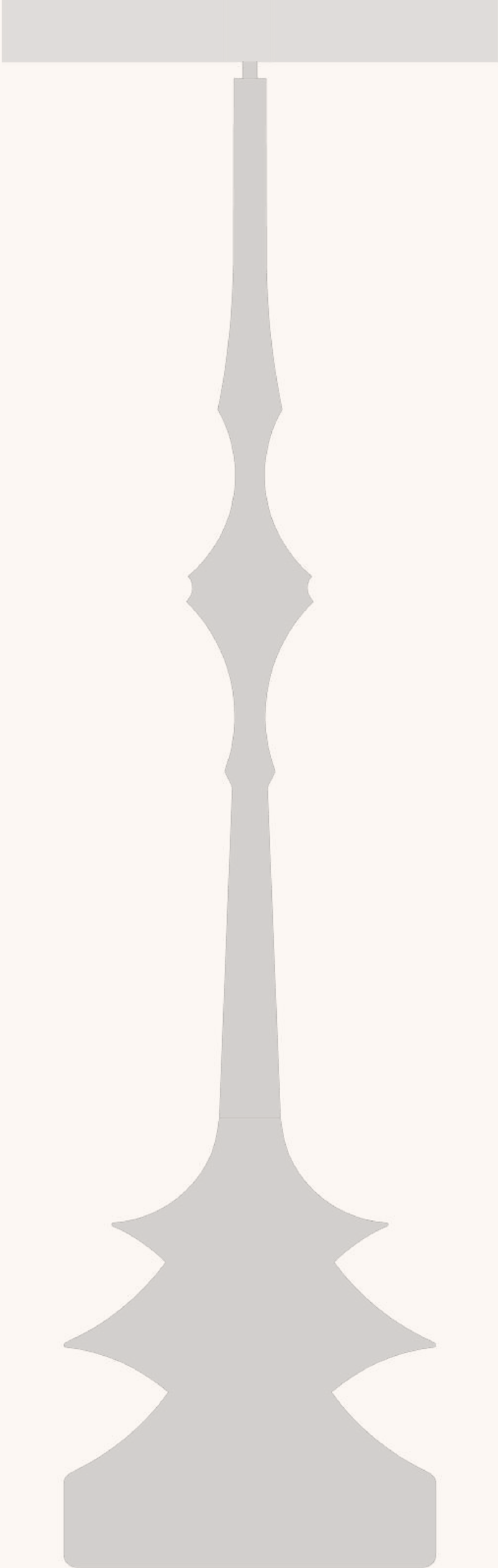

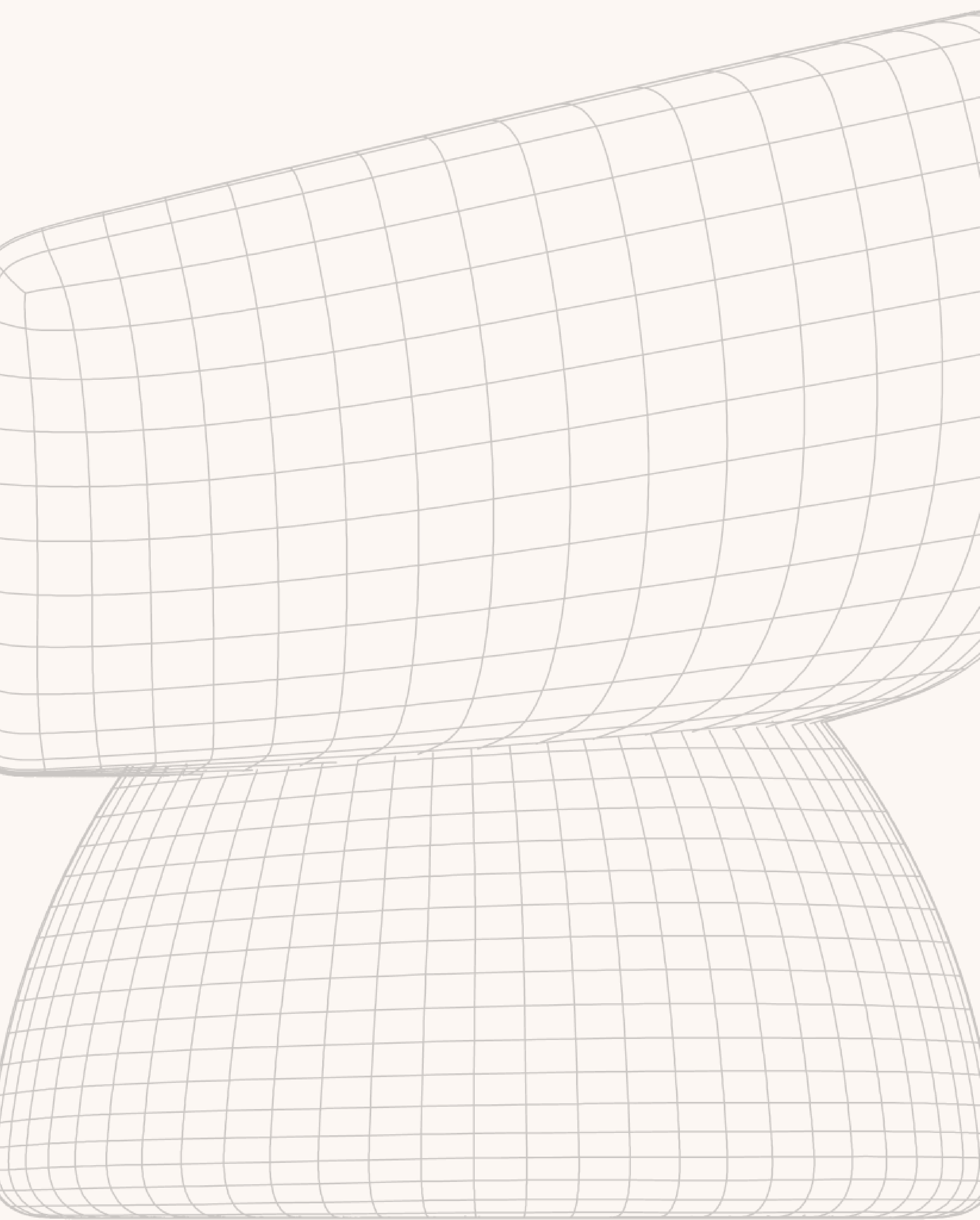

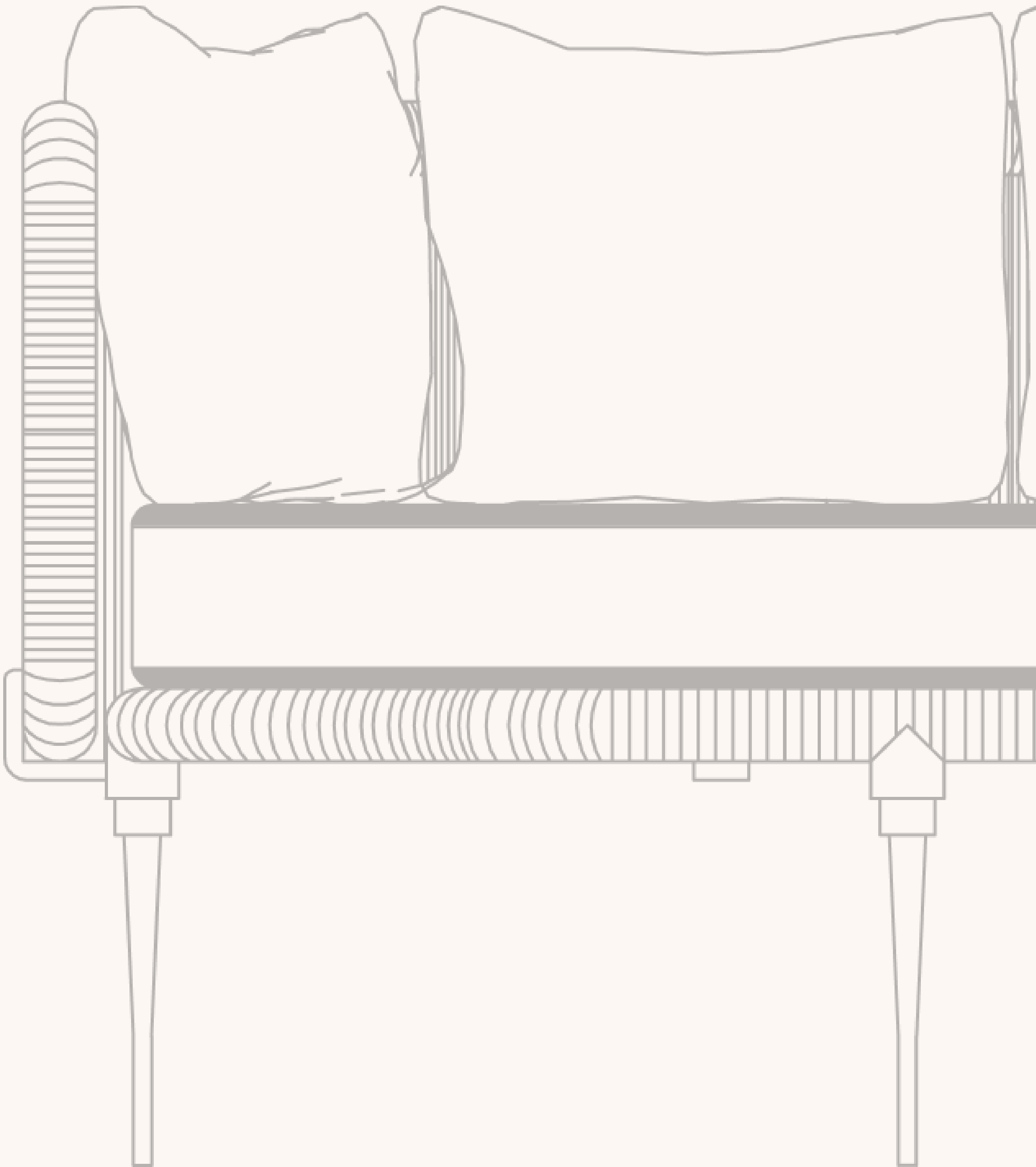

TURNING TABLES

Furniture & Lighting Studio

Turning Tables is a design studio creating furniture and lighting defined by material clarity, craft, and architectural logic. Founded by architect and designer Attiq Ahmed, the studio treats furniture as small-scale architecture, where structure, proportion, and making shape the form.

Working with wood, stone, metal, and woven materials, Turning Tables collaborates with skilled craftspeople to produce pieces that balance precision with tactility. Traditional techniques are reinterpreted through contemporary forms, resulting in objects that are functional, enduring, and quietly expressive.

Alongside Ahmed's architectural practice AEDL, named Architectural Digest AD100 (2018) | Turning Tables operates independently, focusing on limited editions, bespoke commissions, and experimental object-making.

Featured in exhibitions and international editorial platforms, Turning Tables positions furniture at the intersection of architecture and craft, exploring structure, material, and use as a unified design practice.

Turning Tables is committed to designing and producing furniture that balances function, material integrity, and clarity of form. Grounded in architectural thinking, the brand draws from traditional craft practices while reinterpreting them for contemporary use. Its mission is to create durable and purposeful objects that respect making traditions and respond to present-day living.

Attiq Ahmed is an architect and designer whose work centres on furniture and spatial objects shaped by material clarity, craft, and structural logic. Through Turning Tables, and in parallel with his architectural practice at AEDL and OCCO, he develops pieces that sit between furniture and architecture—defined by proportion, construction, and tactility.

Drawing on woodworking traditions, stone craft, and vernacular building practices, his work explores how materials are joined, weighted, and experienced over time. Each piece is conceived as a functional object and a study in structure, where making is integral to design.

Ahmed's broader research into the built environment of Pakistan informs his approach to furniture, grounding contemporary forms in cultural continuity and material intelligence.
